2019 Project Mudd Grant Application Overview

Purpose of the program: Project Mudd organizers have mutually agreed the 2019 proceeds will be awarded to organizations that improve the lives of those living in our local communities.* Funding must be used within 12 months of awarding. Recipients are required to provide quarterly progress reports to ensure appropriate spending and benefits of grant money. Organizations can apply for a minimum of \$1,000 to a maximum of \$5,000. (Award amounts are dependent on funding raised.) Proceed awarding will be administered by Continental Divide Electric Cooperative Inc. (CDEC). Deadline to apply is Friday, June 14, 2019, at 5 p.m.

* For the purpose of this program, a “local community” is defined as one located within CDEC’s service territory. Project Mudd organizers are Macario “Mac” Juarez Jr., of CDEC; Cynthia Tena, of Cibola General Hospital; and Joaquin Jiron, of the City of Grants Recreation Department.

Eligibility requirements:

- Any organization is eligible to apply, so long as the grant will be used to serve a public purpose consistent with program guidelines listed on this application.
- Grant funds must be used for a cause to improve the lives of those living in a local community in one or more of the following charitable-giving categories:
 1. Community Development
 2. Education
 3. Environment
 4. Health
 5. Human Services
 6. Other

Grant limit: An organization can apply for a minimum grant of \$1,000 to a maximum grant of \$5,000.

If a grant is awarded: Grant money must be used within 12 months of awarding. Quarterly progress reports and a final report on the project’s outcome must be submitted. Project Mudd organizers reserve the right to use photos and information about the grant award in its publicity.

Application deadline and delivery: Friday, June 14, 2019, at 5 p.m.
